AN ORDINANCE to amend "An Ordinance to provide for the Summary Trial and Punishment of Aboriginal Native Offenders in certain Cases."

WHEREAS it is expedient to extend the Powers of Justices of the Peace in regard to the Summary Punishment of Aboriginal Natives; Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies by and with the Advice and Consent of the Legislative Council thereof, That the first Section of the Ordinance of the Legislative Council 12th Victoria, No. 18, of 1849 shall be read and applied as if the Words "for any Term not exceeding Three Years" had been inserted at the Conclusion thereof instead of the Words "for any Term not exceeding Six Calendar Months."

Preamble.

The punishment under No. 18 of 1849 extended to 3 years.
