AN ACT to amend the Betting Control Act, 1954-1970.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Betting Con*trol Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1970.

- (2) In this Act the Betting Control Act, 1954-1970, is referred to as the principal Act.
- (3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Betting Control Act, 1954-1970.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the first Commenceday of January nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

Paragraph (a) of subsection (5) of section Amendment to s. 15. 15 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words "that day shall retain sixty per makers on centum" in line four the passage "the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy shall retain fifty per centum".
