

BETTING CONTROL (No. 2).

No. 75 of 1970.

**AN ACT to amend the Betting Control Act,
1954-1970.**

[Assented to 17th November, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Betting Control Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1970.*

(2) In this Act the Betting Control Act, 1954-1970, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Betting Control Act, 1954-1970.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of January nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

Commencement.

3. Paragraph (a) of subsection (5) of section 15 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words "that day shall retain sixty per centum" in line four the passage "the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy shall retain fifty per centum".

Amendment to s. 15.
(Payment of tax by book-makers on bets made at race meetings.)

4. Section 16A of the principal Act is repealed.

Repeal of s. 16A.
(Betting investment tax to be paid on off-course turnover.)
