

CONSTITUTION CONTINUANCE.

AN ACT to continue the operation of the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1931.

[Reserved 4th January, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1931*, *Continuance Act, 1933*, and shall be read as one with the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1931 (No. 11 of 1931), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title

2. (1.) The principal Act shall continue in force until the end of the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, and no longer. Continuance of Act.

(2.) Section five of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "thirty-three" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "thirty-four."
