AN ACT to amend the Elementary Education Act, 1871, Amendment Act, 1893.

[Assented to 5th November, 1912.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Elementary Education Act* Short title.  
*Amendment Act, 1912.*

2. Any member of a District Board of Education appointed, before or after the commencement of this Act, by the Governor under the provisions of section fourteen of the Elementary Education Act, 1871, Amendment Act, 1893, may be removed by the Governor at his pleasure.
