

MARKETING OF BARLEY (CONTINUANCE).

AN ACT to amend the Marketing of Barley Act, 1946.

[Assented to 24th August, 1949.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Marketing of Barley Act Amendment (Continuance) Act, 1949*, and shall be read as one with the Marketing of Barley Act, 1946 (No. 17 of 1946), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Marketing of Barley Act, 1946-1949. Citation of principal Act as amended by this Act.

3. Section forty-one of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words "for three years after the date of its proclamation" in lines one and two, the words "until the ninth day of December one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two." Amendment of s. 41.
