AN ACT to amend the Plant Diseases Act, 1914-1956.

[Assented to 29th September, 1958.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Plant Diseases Act Amendment Act, 1958*.

(2) In this Act the Plant Diseases Act, 1914-1956,

is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Plant Diseases Act, 1914-1958.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commence-
ment.

3. Section eight of the principal Act is amended— S. 8
amended.

(a) by substituting for the passage, “applied for annually on or before the first day of July in each year, and shall have effect for one year:” in lines two and three of subsection (3), the passage, “made at the times and for the periods prescribed.”; and

(b) by repealing the proviso to subsection (3).
