AN ACT to amend the Railways Amendment Act, 1879.

[Assented to, 27th October, 1896.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Railways Amendment Act, 1896, and shall be incorporated and be read as one Act with the Railways Amendment Act, 1879, and any Act amending the same.

Short title and incorporation.

2. SECTION thirteen of the Railways Amendment Act, 1879, is hereby amended by adding after the word "money," in the thirty-fourth line, the following words:—"or in the investment on mortgage of freeholds in the said Colony or purchase of Municipal Debentures."

Amendment of Sec. 13 of Railways Amendment Act, 1879.
