**AN ACT to amend the Reciprocal Enforcement of
Maintenance Orders Act, 1921.**

[Assented to 19th September, 1958.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Reciprocal Enforcement of Maintenance Orders Act Amendment Act, 1958.*

(2) In this Act the Reciprocal Enforcement of Maintenance Orders Act, 1921,

Act No. 27 of 1921 as amended by Acts Nos. 29 of 1923 and 7 of 1936,

is referred to as the principal Act.

- (c) after the word, "Dominions" in line four of subsection (3), the words, "or of any other country";
- (d) after the word, "part" in lines four and eight of subsection (3), the words, "or that country";
- (e) after the word, "Dominions" in line eleven of subsection (3), the words, "or of any other country"; and
- (f) a subsection as follows—

(7) The Governor may by Order in Council extend this Act to any other country with such modification (if any) as the Governor may by the same or any other Order in Council declare.
