**AN ACT to amend the Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899.**

*[Assented to 20 March 1985.]*

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Constitution Amendment Act 1984*. Short title.

2. Schedule IV to the Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899 is repealed and the following schedule substituted—

“ SCHEDULE IV.

Governor—

On and after 2 July 1984, amounts at the rate of 70 per cent. of the rate at which the salary of the Chief Justice of Western Australia is payable for the time being or, if that office of Chief Justice is vacant, would be so payable if that office were not vacant. ”
