

JUSTICES.

No. 44 of 1984.

AN ACT to amend the Justices Act 1902-1982.

[Assented to 5 September 1984.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Justices Amendment Act 1984*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Justices Act 1902-1982 is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted as approved 30 November 1977 and amended by Acts Nos. 6 and 67 of 1979, 67 of 1980, 120 of 1981 and 20, 124 and 125 of 1982.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Justices Act 1902-1984.

Section 201
amended.

2. Section 201 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (3) the following subsection—

“ (4) Where a recognisance referred to in subsection (1) of this section is given following an order to review granted in relation to a conviction under the Road Traffic Act 1974 any disqualification from holding or obtaining a licence to drive a vehicle pursuant to that Act in respect of such conviction is suspended until the order to review is disposed of and any period during which the disqualification is so suspended shall not be taken into account in determining the period of the disqualification. ”.
